Hi Drew,

When I first became aware of the contentious issues on Hatteras Island related to roads, beach closures, etc., I didn't have an opinion—but I did have a deep desire to understand what the controversy was all about. I spent a lot of time researching the issues, including making a personal visit to Defenders of Wildlife (DOW) headquarters in Washington, DC. In addition to my visit to DOW I exchanged emails with them and had a number of lengthy phone calls. I also had extended communications with Southern Environmental Law Center (SELC), DOW's law firm.

Here is a high-level summary of my conclusions:

- 1) DOW doesn't really care all that much about Hatteras Island. They see Hatteras Island as part of the bigger issue of the environmental movement as a whole. They fight the battles on Hatteras Island because they believe in the Domino Theory—"If we don't fight on Hatteras Island, next thing you know other more significant environmental issues will come under assault."
- 2) SELC is just like any other law firm—they will do their best to represent the wishes of their client zealously. When it comes to Hatteras Island SELC isn't acting on any sort of moral high ground. They are simply advocating for their client the same way that a good attorney would defend a criminal even if the attorney knew the client was guilty.
- 3) DOW and SELC don't fight fair and they don't care about facts. At one point I was able to get SELC to modify a press release because it was inaccurate. Both DOW and SELC are very good at committing errors of omission. It's rare for them to lie, but is also rare for them to tell the full truth.

My best advice to you is to ignore input from all advocacy groups (both sides) and just look at the facts. You might be receiving a bunch of letters from DOW and SELC supporters because they are rallying their membership and asking them to weigh in. I can promise you that most of the people you hear from will not understand the situation. You might also be getting similar letters that take the other side of the issue as a reaction to the DOW and SELC call to action.

Having looked at all this pretty deeply for a few years now I'm of the opinion that there is plenty of room on Hatteras Island for animals and people. A reliable road is needed. At some point in the future, maybe 50 or 100 years from now it not make sense to have a road to Hatteras Island. But today a road does make sense.

I appreciate you taking the time to read this email. Please let me know if I can be of any service to NCDOT.
