Soon you'll be able to escape the agony of bumper-to-bumper traffic and get back to your life faster with the new Triangle Expressway—North Carolina's first modern toll road.

***The first phase of the Triangle Expressway will open in December 2011, and offers a quicker, more convenient route to the Research Triangle Park area.***

Once the second phase is completed, you will have nearly 20 miles of stress-free commute from the Research Triangle Park area down to Holly Springs.

***Together both phases can shorten your commute by up to 40 priceless minutes each day!***



## Traffic Relief Coming Soon

When completed the Triangle Expressway will save commuters up to 40 minutes round trip of congestion-free travel every day. So when can you start using the Triangle Expressway and NC Quick Pass?

### First Phase

- Will open in December 2011
- Connects the N.C. 147 and I-40 interchange to N.C. 540 near Research Triangle Park
- Connects N.C. 540 between N.C. 55 and N.C. 54

### Second Phase

- Will open later in 2012
- Connects N.C. 55 near Research Triangle Park to the N.C. 55 Bypass south of Holly Springs

You'll be prompted to establish a prepaid toll account with a \$20 deposit when you purchase your NC Quick Pass. Tolls are automatically deducted from your prepaid account as you travel on any North Carolina toll road. Visit [www.ncquickpass.com](http://www.ncquickpass.com) for more details.

For added convenience, you can manage your toll account online at [www.ncquickpass.com](http://www.ncquickpass.com). To keep your balance current, you can automatically replenish your account with a credit card, debit card and bank withdrawals or with check or money order payments mailed to or received in person at our Customer Service Center. You can also use our automated phone system at 1-877-7MY-PASS. Cash payments must be made in person at our Customer Service Center.
